1. Representation in High-Value Inheritance Dispute – AED 23,394,961.78. Represented the Claimant before the Dubai Court in a complex inheritance dispute involving estate distributions derived from real estate returns, deposits, and bonds. The total value of the claim amounted to AED 23,394,961.78. The matter concerned the Claimant's entitlement to proceeds from the deceased's estate, and required comprehensive legal strategy, evidentiary analysis, and coordination with financial institutions to establish the rightful claims.
2. Represented (the Defendant) before the Dubai Court in a case filed by (Claimant) seeking the return of a cheque valued at AED 3,000,000. Successfully challenged the Plaintiff's claims, and the court ultimately ruled to dismiss the lawsuit in Favor of the Defendant.
