Cases

Case No. 9/20** | Commercial Appeal**

Commercial dispute (AED 29 million) successfully resolved in favour of our client, with full recovery, compensation, interest, and costs awarded.

Case No. 16/20** | Cassation – Extradition Case**

In a significant extradition case initiated by a European jurisdiction against our client, a request was submitted for his surrender. We acted in his defense, and the extradition request was successfully rejected. The Public Prosecution subsequently filed a cassation appeal; however, the Court relied on the defenses he submitted and ultimately dismissed the appeal, upholding the refusal of extradition.
